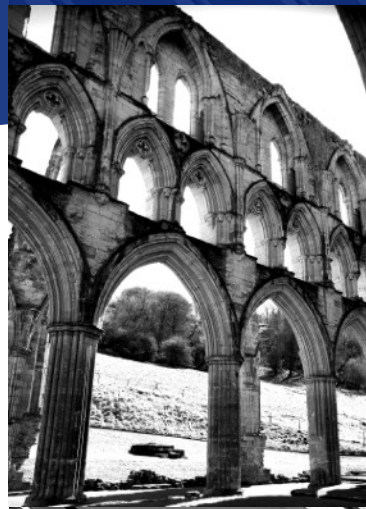


BGST CHURCH HISTORY TOUR 3: THE SPIRITUAL LEGACY OF BRITISH CHRISTIANITY

7 – 18 AUG 2019

The aim of this church history tour is to introduce participants to the historical and spiritual legacy of British Christianity, from its early roots in the 4th century Celtic Christianity, to medieval English monasticism, the English and Scottish Reformations, the Great Evangelical Awakening of the 18th century (led by George Whitefield and John Wesley), the contributions of British scholars to New Testament Scholarship, and to the teachings of 20th century luminaries such as C.S Lewis, Dorothy Sayers and J.R.R. Tolkien. We shall also survey the biblical artefacts displayed at the British Museum.

Edinburgh Castle, National Museum of Scotland; Vindolanda Museum-Hadrian's Wall; Lindisfarne Holy Island; Durham Cathedral & Castle; Rievaulx Abbey, York, Cambridge University (includes Punting Tour), Julian of Norwich's Church, Canterbury Cathedral, St Augustine's Abbey, The Canterbury Tales Tour, Westminster Abbey, Wesley's Chapel & Museum of Methodism; Oxford University; C.S. Lewis' home and tomb.

PRICING DETAILS
